PULASKI TOURNAMENT

Boys' Tournament Rules and Reminders

- 1. Awards Awards will be awarded to all grade level winners. Must be present.
- 2. <u>Balls</u> will not be provided for warm-ups:
- 3. <u>An adult must provide supervision</u> at all times in any area of Pulaski schools. You and your team will be responsible for any damage! Destruction of property could result in disqualification.
- 4. <u>No shooting</u> during half time or between games by anyone not involved in the game in progress.
- 5. <u>Each player should</u> wear a numbered uniform.
- 6. <u>Timing:</u> **ALL Games:** 20 minute halves with running clock until the <u>last minute</u> of each half. Clock <u>will not</u> stop when shooting free throws unless it is the last minute of each half.
- 7. Free Throws: **Grades 3 and 4** a 12 foot FT line will be used.
- 8. <u>Half time</u> will be 4 minutes. These times may be adjusted slightly to remain on schedule.
- 9. <u>Scorers and timers:</u> Each team must provide an official scorer or timer for the game if one is not provided for you.
- 10. Overtime- First team to score a point; sudden death.
- 11. <u>Technical fouls</u> will not be shot. Two points and the ball for player and bench technical fouls.
- 12. Pressing:

 3^{rd} - 6^{th} grade: no pressing until the last two minutes of the game.

7th - 8th grade: pressing allowed at any time. However, no press when up by 20 points or more.

13. Defense:

3rd-6th Grade - Man to Man Defense only

7th-8th Grade - Any Defense

- 14. <u>Timeouts</u> Two -30 seconds timeouts per half. One additional per overtime period.
- 15. <u>Waiver or release:</u> The Pulaski Community School District, the Pulaski JRR, the Management of this Tournament, or any Team Manager shall not be held responsible for personal injury to any player or person or loss of team or individual property during this Tournament.
